Solution 1: Force quit the application. On a PC, you can press (and hold) Ctrl+Alt+Delete (the Control, Alt, and Delete keys) on your keyboard to open the Task Manager. On a Mac, press and hold Command+Option+Esc. You can then select the unresponsive application and click End task (or Force Quit on a Mac) to close it.

Immediately after your Mac restarts (some Mac computers play a startup sound), press and hold the command * and R keys until the Apple logo appears, then release the keys. Select Disk Utility, then Continue. Select your hard drive, then select First Aid at the top. A message telling you First Aid will check and repair errors.

Check pins in connectors. System Starts and Freezes. Restart the Mac. Unhook all SCSI devices and restart the Mac. Restart with the shift key down (turns off extensions) Remove all extensions and add them back one at a time - restart the Mac after each addition, if using System 7.5 or higher, use Extensions Manager.

If your left MacBook Pro I/O board (Motherboard) is bad or faulty, you will not be able to start your computer when it's plugged into the wall. It may or may not run on battery and the light on the power adapter will not light up at all (some power adapters do not have lights, so this may not apply to your computer).
